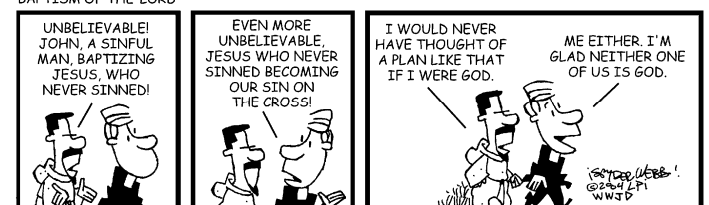

Pastoral Column

Our cluster begins the Parish Assessment and Renewal (PAR) Process this week. The first part of this process is a random survey, which provides an opportunity for parishioners to give feedback on strengths and weaknesses of our parishes. Surveys have already (or will soon) be going out in the mail. Surveys are being sent according to a random numbering system provided to us by the PAR office. In some cases, because of the randomness of the numbering system, more than one person in a household may receive a survey. In those cases, we ask that each individual fills out the survey separate.

Each person who receives a survey is assigned a survey number in our office to keep track of who returns the surveys. A return envelope is included in the packet with your survey number on it, but not your name. When your survey arrives in your parish office, we will mark off your number so we know that you have completed your survey. Those who do not return the survey within two weeks will receive a phone call from someone on the Survey Committee. **ALTHOUGH WE WILL KNOW WHO RETURNED SURVEYS, ALL SURVEYS WILL BE FORWARDED UNOPENED TO THE PAR OFFICE.** Staff at the PAR office will compile comments that will be used during the assessment process in April. It is important for you to know that no one in our parish offices will be reading your comments and no one at the PAR office will know who wrote what because they won't have a list of names that correspond to the survey numbers on the return envelope. Therefore, your comments will remain completely anonymous.

If you receive a survey, we ask that you please take time to diligently answer the questions. Be completely honest. We have entered into this process to improve our three parishes and the way we are able to minister to our parishioners. We want to hear about the ways we minister well, and what areas upon which we need to improve our ministry. Three of the things we want to understand in this process are what should we *keep* doing, what should we *stop* doing and what should we *start* doing.

Your input is vital in the process. There will be a limited number of extra surveys available if you do not receive one and would like to fill one out. Contact your parish office to request one. They will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis. *Please know that if you do not have the opportunity to fill out a survey, there will be other opportunities for you to give your input in this process.*

Please pray with me that the PAR process will be a success and that we will continue to find ways to offer better ministry to all of God's people in need.
