

HOME & SCHOOL MEETING
September 9, 2009

1. Meeting called to order at 6:32. Paula Mayer led the meeting with a prayer.
2. **Secretary's Report:** Lina Vorpahl accepted the minutes; seconded by Amy Bares.
3. **Principal's Report:** None present.
4. **Teacher's Report:** Rhonda Goetsch reported the school year is going well with the classes running smoothly.

The Brat fry at the Cheese Store made \$176 just from baked goods and brought in approximately \$800 total with official numbers still pending. A note will be sent home next week regarding profits from the Entertainment Book. The Meet and Greet went well with a very good turnout. The teachers would have liked a chance to speak with the parents as they had done in the past, and that will be looked into for next year.
7. **New Business:** Paula went over the volunteer list and handed out forms. Our next event is the Fall Fest and volunteers are still needed for chili makers and ideas for activities. Paula will be taking over the magazine sale with tentatively Sept. 17 as the kick-off date. The Wine and Cheese Tasting tickets will go out soon. Tickets will be \$25 in advance and \$30 at the door. This event will be Oct. 17 from 6:30 to 9:30. Glasses will be donated for this event. As of today, only 6 vendors are scheduled for the Craft Fair whereas last year 22 were scheduled by this time.. A decision needs to be made soon on the future of this event. Jenny Huiras will look into scheduling Ice Bowling for some time in January. A calendar raffle was discussed for next year instead of the football raffle. Curt made a motion to accept and look into this; seconded by Terry Singer. Stacy Bichler will set up the Cheese/Candle sale. Child care was discussed for future H&S meetings. Amy Bares will look into a roller-skating party in the future at Skateland in Cedarburg. \$300 was made in the Bucks games last year. \$10 per ticket goes back to the school. Paula will look into future games.
